List your activities.
 On a separate sheet of paper, list the high school, college and/or community activities in which you have made a significant contribution. Please state the activity, briefly describe your contributions and list the years you were involved.

Complete this Scholarship Application and submit it to the Student Affairs office by March 1, 2018. Include your Essay, statement of eligibility and activities page.
