



**Altrusa International of Marshfield
Scholarship Fund**

Scholarship Application Form

The Altrusa International Club of Marshfield has established a scholarship fund for a minimum of \$500 for non-traditional students. The number and amount of scholarships awarded shall be determined annually. The selection of scholarship recipient(s) shall be made solely by the Scholarship Committee of Altrusa International of Marshfield.

Specific criteria are as follows:

- The applicant must be a resident of the Marshfield area. The Marshfield area is defined as within a thirty-mile radius of Marshfield.
- The applicant must be accepted as an undergraduate at an accredited post-secondary college, university or technical school in the Marshfield area during the next succeeding term at minimum 6 credits.
- The applicant must be a non-traditional student who is:
 - A post high school graduate that has been out of high school for a minimum of five years.
 - A post high school graduate pursuing an academic or vocational degree.
 - A post high school graduate, who, having been in the work force or due to extenuating circumstances, is attempting to better their career standing or change careers by pursuing an academic or vocational degree.
- Past Altrusa Scholarship recipients are not eligible to reapply.
